## Directions to America's Keswick

Take Schuylkill Expy East. Keep left onto I-676 (US 30) towards I-676 / US 30 / Central Philadelphia.  
Turn right onto ramp towards I-676 E / US 30 E / Ben Franklin Br.

Bear RIGHT (South) onto N 6th St.

Take Ramp (LEFT) onto I-676 [US-30] towards I-676 / US-30 / I-95

Entering New Jersey

Keep LEFT onto US-30 towards US-30 / US-130 /

New Jersey Turnpike / Cherry Hill / Trenton

Bear LEFT (East) onto SR-38 [Kaighn Ave]

Keep RIGHT onto SR-70 [CR-601

Take Ramp onto I-295 towards I-295 / Mt Holly / Trenton

At exit 40A, take Ramp (RIGHT) onto SR-38 towards RT-38 / Mt. Holly

Road name changes to CR-530 [S Pemberton Rd]

Turn LEFT (North) onto CR-530 [CR-616]

Turn RIGHT (East) onto CR-530 [Elizabeth St]

Turn RIGHT (South-East) onto CR-530 [Juliestown Rd]

Keep STRAIGHT onto SR-70 [CR-530]

Turn RIGHT (South) onto CR-530 [CR-539], then immediately turn LEFT (East) onto Old Lacey Rd

Turn LEFT (East) onto CR-530 [Lacey Rd]

Bear LEFT (East) onto CR-530 [Pinewald Keswick Rd]

Arrive 601 CR-530, Manchester TWP, NJ 08759

Moses was a man of God who thirsted to know the heart of God. The Bible tells us that *"the Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks with his friend"* (Exodus 33:11). God clearly desires that we know His heart, for that is what friends share. When Moses asked Him, *"Now show me Your glory"* (Exodus 33:18), he was asking to know the very heart of his majestic God. God's astonishing answer was found as *"the Lord came down in the cloud and stood there with him and proclaimed his name... the Lord, the Lord the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness... forgiving wickedness, rebellion, and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished..."* (Exodus 34:5-7). God's heart moves Him relentlessly to implement His holy agenda through His redeemed people. Isaiah tells us that when justice is driven back, when righteousness stands at a distance, when truth stumbles in the streets, when honesty cannot enter, when truth is nowhere to be found, when whoever shuns evil becomes a prey... when the Lord sees this and there is no one among His people to intervene, He is displeased and appalled (see Isaiah 59:14-16). He then comes Himself to work salvation, and says, *"My son, give me your heart"* (Proverbs 23:26). In exchange, He gives us His own heart. Simply put, Jesus says over and over, *"Follow Me"*. The calling of the redeemed is to walk in His ways with His heart. We are to put feet on our faith, to carry us into our communities in practical ministries of mercy & love, of justice & truth. How else will the world know our great & gracious God, except it sees & hears Him through our lives?
